

How Do I Apply for Graduate Admissions?

Step 1: Complete and submit the Application. The application for admissions can be filled out on the seminary website or by requesting a copy from the TIBS office. Completed applications can be mailed or emailed to the TIBS office. The application must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$25.00 deposit.

Step 2: Submit post-secondary transcripts. The applicant must request to have an official post-secondary transcript sent to TIBS.

- Transcript must include the total credit hours and cumulative grade point average and graduation date.
- The applicant's cumulative grade point average must be at least a 2.00 (on a 4.00 scale)

Step 3: Submit a pastor's recommendation. A Pastor's Recommendation form is included with the application. Applicants should deliver the form to their pastor and have him send the completed form directly to TIBS. No student will be allowed to attend TIBS without the full recommendation of their local church pastor.
